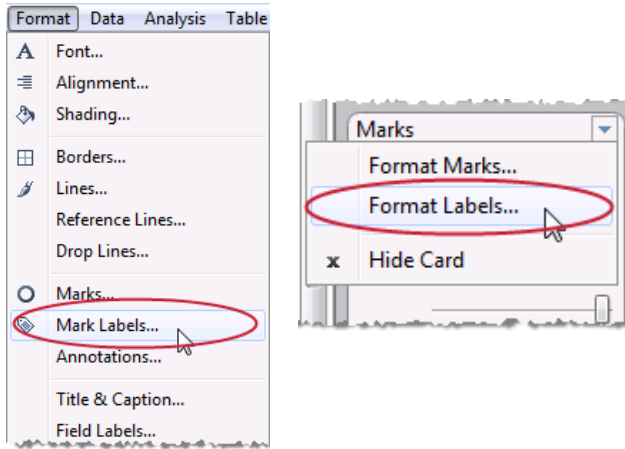


Mark Labels

Draw attention to specific values using mark labels. Mark Labels are values shown next to each data point in the view. You can show mark labels for all marks, just selected or highlighted marks, minimum and maximum values, or just on the ends of a line.

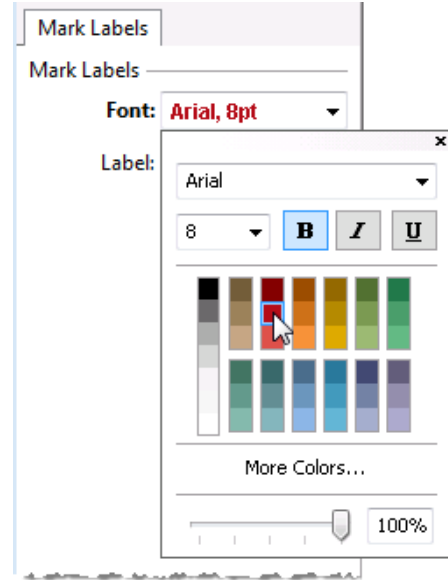
1 Select Format > Mark Labels

Open the format window by selecting **Format > Mark Labels**. You can also select **Format Labels** on the marks card menu.



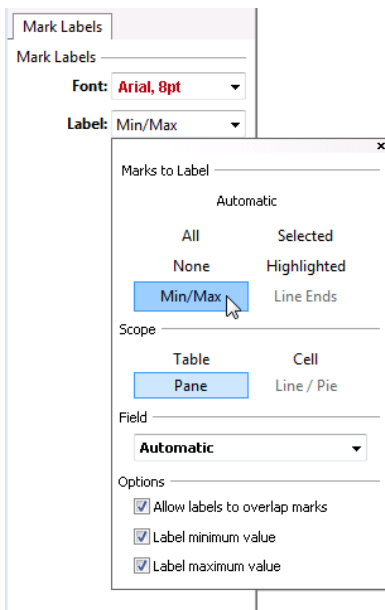
2 Select Font Options

Use the **Font** control to specify the font, size, and color of the label.



3 Specify What to Label

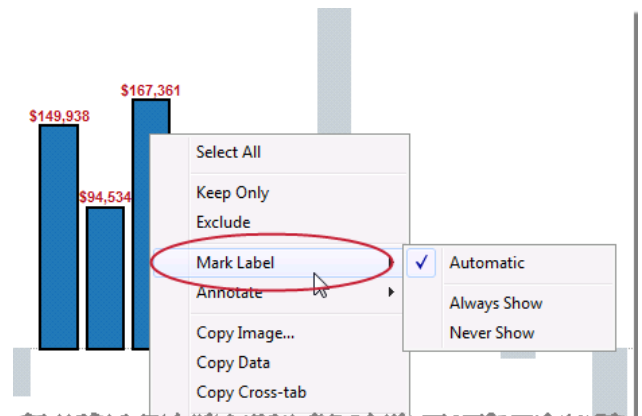
Use the **Label** control to specify which marks to label. For example you can label only minimum and maximum marks or only marks that are selected.



When set to Automatic, labels will be shown automatically based on whether a field is on the Text shelf and the density of marks in the view.

4 Refine the Labels

After specifying the general label settings you can turn labels on and off for individual marks. Right-click a mark and select an option on the **Mark Labels** sub-menu.



These options override the settings you specified in the Format window.
