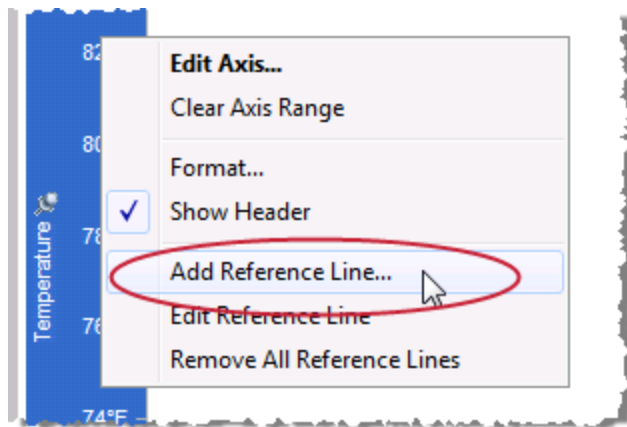


Reference Bands

Shade a region of the view between two constant or computed values using any measure in the view. For example, in a view showing temperatures over time, you may add a reference band to indicate the ideal temperature range.

1 Right-click and Add Reference Line

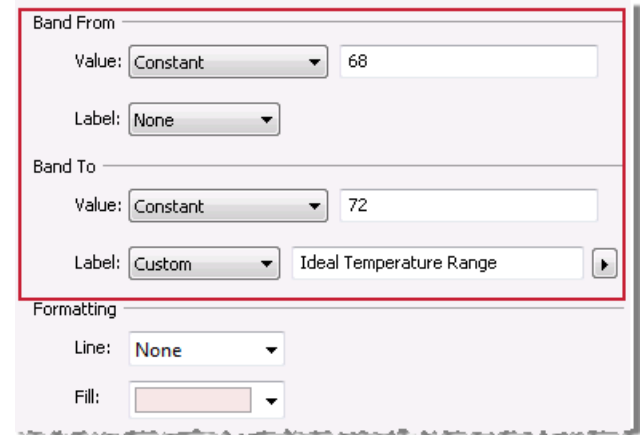
Right-click an axis and select **Add Reference Line**. In the Reference Line dialog box, select Band.



Edit reference lines later by right-clicking the axis and selecting Edit Reference Line.

2 Specify a Range of Values

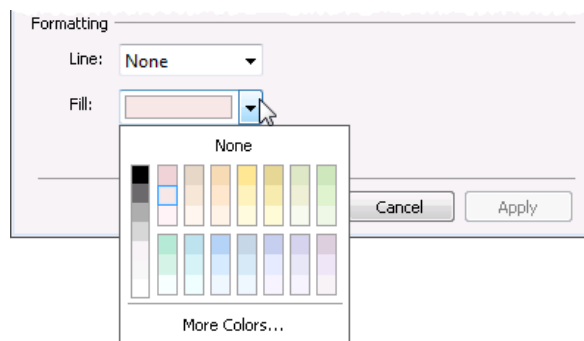
Use the **Value** drop-down menus to specify computed or constant values as the range of values.



Drag measures to the Level of Detail shelf to make them available as reference bands.

3 Format the Band

Specify formatting options such as line style, color, and fill color.



4 Edit the Reference Band

Make changes to the reference band by right-clicking the axis and selecting **Edit Reference Line**.
