

## Changing Tool-tip

Hovering over a mark in Tableau produces a tool-tip. Tool-tips contain a quick summary of the values for each field in the view. In 5.0, it is possible to modify the tool-tip order and content.

Use the example Superstore provided with Tableau.

## Modifying the order of the tool-tip

Tool-tips list in alphabetical order the values available.

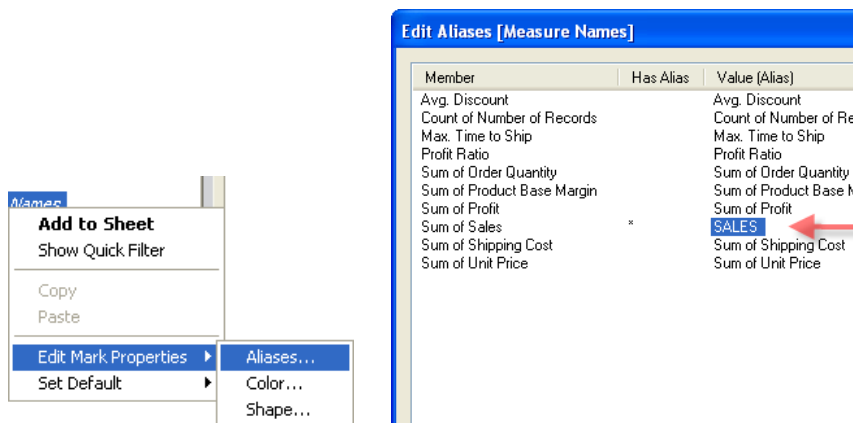
To change the dimensions, you can rename the original fields or make a copy of the fields and rename new field. If you use a numbering scheme, the tool-tip will organize the data correctly.

Rename Region to "1. Region", Customer State to "2. Customer State", and Product 1-Category to "3.Product 1-Category". Double-click on "2. Customer State". Move "1. Region" to the **Level of Detail shelf**. Move "3.Product 1-Category" to Color shelf.

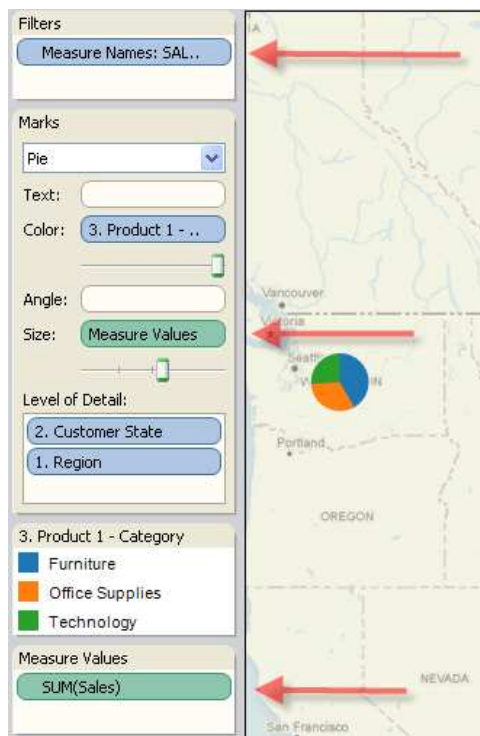
Change the **Marks** to **Pie**.

To change the names of measures, you will need to move **Measure Names** into the **Filter shelf**. Select the value(s) you want to see. In this example, select Sum of Sales.

Then right click on the **Measure Names** in the **Dimension window** and choose **Edit Mark Properties** > **Aliases**. Change the names as needed. Change the alias for Sum of Sales to Sales.



Move **Measure Values** to the location needed. In this example, put the **Measure Values** on the **Size shelf**.

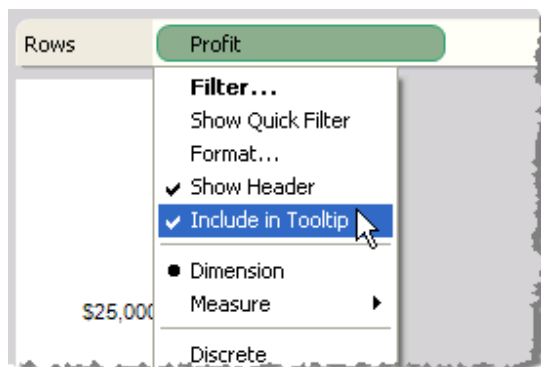


Move your mouse over the pie in Idaho and see the new tool-tip



## Limiting what is a Tool-tip

Right-click on the fields on the view.



Remove the check next to **Include in Tooltip**. This will remove that field from the tool-tip.

Note: Sets cannot be removed from the tool-tip. If you have two fields and a set made from the two fields, remove the check for the fields not the set.
